Mark Gazette hosted his first CSPMA meeting in the Corwin International Magnet School. This school was recently re-commissioned and is doing very well. It is similar in concept to a charter school with an international Bachelorette education theme. Kristina Hunter, a 4th grade teacher, did a water crossing video, demonstrating studies using SKYPE as a tool to share resources and interaction with students from across the globe. Today's video utilized students from Germany and New Zealand for example.

The Principal, Julie Schue shared how the magnet school concept was developed and implemented. Currently it is more popular on the east coast but moving west very rapidly. A Pueblo D-60 consists of 23 elementary, 6 middle schools, and 4 high schools. It has 3.2 million sq. ft of space. There are 4 support buildings and 3 football stadiums. It also has one alternative education building. Utility Monitoring - Brian Stone did a school dude presentation utilizing Utility Direct for energy management. He shared the various reports and data input levels available and provided all with a thumb drive demonstrating utility direct capabilities.

Wayne Blazek gave an overview of the facility assessment that CDE will be performing over the next several months. Some schools have already had site visits from the CDE sub contractors. End results will not be available until later in the year.
